

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE GRAND LODGE OF ANCIENT FREE AND ACCEPTED MASONS OF MARYLAND

AMEND ARTICLE VII, SECTION I BY DELETING THE SECOND SENTENCE WHICH READS AS FOLLOWS

A Grand Secretary who has served ten (10) consecutive elective terms as Grand Secretary, and a Grand Treasurer who has served ten (10) consecutive elective terms as Grand Treasurer, shall not be eligible for re-election or appointment to his respective office for one year after his last term in that office.

ARTICLE XVI

Subordinate Lodges

(Old language in brackets), new language underlined

Section 7, Membership H, Suspension, Non-Payment of Dues and Assessments - Any member of a lodge who fails to pay his regular dues and the per capita assessment for support and maintenance of the Masonic Homes for (one year) six months shall be suspended, without trial, effective on (December 31) June 30 of the year of his delinquency.

- 1. The Notice to a member of the intention to suspend shall explain the penalty for which he renders himself liable for non-payment of dues and assessments, which includes the loss by him and his dependents of eligibility for admission to the Maryland Masonic Homes. The notice shall be sent by registered or certified mail, return receipts requested, to his residence if known, or if unknown then to the address of his last known residence, which shall be deemed a legal notice. This notice shall be sent at least one week prior to (December 1) June 1, and at least 30 days prior to action being taken on his delinquency by the Lodge. Proof of notice shall be maintained by the lodge and recorded in the minutes of its proceedings,
- 2. The Lodge shall take action to suspend a delinquent member at its first (or second) regular communication (in January) on or after July 1. The suspension shall be effective as of (December 31) June 30, and the suspended member's name shall not be included in the returns of the Lodge to the Grand Secretary.
- 3. Notice of suspension shall include a statement of how a suspended member may regain his membership. It shall be sent promptly by registered or certified mail to his residence if known, or if unknown, then to the address of his last known residence.
- 4. If a member thus suspended pays all of his arrearage <u>plus</u> the cost of all notices and postage associated with his suspension, within six months from the date of his suspension, he shall automatically be reinstated to all the rights and privileges of Masonry. Failing to do so within six months, he may be reinstated

only by paying all arrearages up to the time of his suspension <u>plus</u> the cost of all <u>notices and postage associated with his suspension</u> and petitioning the Lodge for reinstatement.

- 5. If a member pays his arrearage <u>plus</u> the cost of all notices and <u>postage</u> after six months and his petition for reinstatement is rejected, he becomes an unaffiliated Mason. He may then petition any other Lodge for affiliation.
- 6. Nothing herein shall affect the right of the Lodge to remit the dues, per capita tax and assessment of a member.

Note: This Proposed Amendment would become effective beginning with dues and assessments due for the year 2014.

Edict of the Most Worshipful Grand Master Gerald E. Piepiora

Right of Visitation:

Effective immediately, a brother who does not possess a current year's membership card (having only one from the previous year), and although not yet suspended, is not considered to be "in good standing" (Article XVI.10.I)

He, therefore loses the right of visitation. At that point, he may visit a Maryland Lodge only upon invitation of the Worshipful Master. This also applies to all Masonic bodies where a current dues card is required for admission.
